1. REFERENCES.

- a. Executive Order 13423, Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management, 24 Jan 07.
- b. Army Regulation 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement.

2. PURPOSE. This memorandum sets forth the JBM-HH policy governing environmental protection and sustainability through implementation of the Environmental Management System (EMS).

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy is applicable to all military, civilian personnel and contractors who live, work or are authorized access to the JBM-HH community.

4. POLICY. The JBM-HH community conducts operations and mission support functions to train, mobilize, sustain and deploy combat-ready forces by operating, maintaining and repairing infrastructure and facilities to create a world class installation. To accomplish the mission, we commit to:

- a. Comply with all applicable environmental policies, laws and regulations.
- b. Continually assess activities and services to determine environmental impacts and ensure that they are considered in environmental program objectives.
- c. Promote environmental awareness through training and publicity.
- d. Prevent pollution at the source wherever and whenever possible and identify, research and implement pollution prevention opportunities to reduce the use of hazardous materials and generation of municipal solid and hazardous waste.
