FMMC goes green with single stream recycling

- Single Stream Recycling means instead of separating recyclables into two streams you will now be able to put these two streams together into one bin.
- Blue Bins seen throughout the FMMC can be used for all clean recycled materials – except cardboard. Place all paper (newspaper, colored paper, and office paper), glass, plastic bottles and aluminum cans into the same bin!
- Do not place wood pallets, batteries, toner cartridges, and scrap metal in either recycling or solid waste dumpsters not specifically marked for the collection of these items. These recyclable materials shall be segregated and turned in via special pick-up arranged through JBMHH DPW by calling the Work Coordination Branch at 703-696-3263.
- FMMC also recycles lead acid batteries and used toner cartridges. Contact the DPW Environmental Division to arrange for pickup of these items.
- Recycling helps protect our resources, our environment, and our quality of life. Recycling reduces the need for landfills, conserves our natural resources and helps sustain the environment for future generations.
- To receive additional recycling containers, add a new recycling pickup point, for special pickups or missed pickups outside buildings, call (703) 696-3210.
