

CPT Bradley M. Wilcox is a native of Santa Clarita, California. He earned a bachelor's degree from California State University, Northridge in May of 2009.

CPT Wilcox commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Adjutant General Corps on September 17, 2009 and was assigned to the 4th Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell, KY.
