

# FBI Mass Transit Advisory

Your vigilance is essential to protect this critical infrastructure. Identify suspicious activity or suspicious items, know what is out of place and notify the proper authorities.

### **What is Considered Suspicious Behavior?**

Acting nervous, irritable or evasive and/or sweating inexplicably

Avoiding eye contact or departing quickly when seen or approached

Attempting to gain access to restricted areas

Wearing unseasonal bulky attire, carrying backpacks and/or packages in an unusual or delicate manner

Taking pictures, videos and/or drawing diagrams or annotating maps

Leaving a package, backpack or briefcase and then hurrying away

People arriving together and then splitting up; these persons may continue to communicate via cell phone

Most all major mass transit attacks have occurred during peak hours and any suspicious activities or items observed during this timeframe should be taken seriously.

Stay alert. Be aware. Your efforts make a difference.

## What Should You Do?

Move away – don't touch suspicious item(s)

Note and provide specific details on: location, time, activity and appearance

Notify transit security and/or call 9-1-1

Your vigilance is essential in identifying suspicious activity or suspicious items. Know what is out of place and notify the proper authorities.

### Examples of Suspicious Behaviors:

- Acting nervous, sweating inexplicably
- Attempting to gain access to restricted areas
- Photographing or videotaping areas of no interest to the general public
- Drawing diagrams or annotating maps
- Leaving packages, briefcases and/or backpacks then hurrying from the area

### Points to Consider:

- Is the item in plain sight or hidden?
- Was it deliberately abandoned? Any witnesses?
- Is it making noise? Are there bulges, protruding wires or bottles attached? Any vapors, mists or strange odors?
- Is there a threat associated with the activity or item?

### What Should You Do?

- Move away - don't touch the suspicious item(s)
- Immediately notify transit security and/or call 9-1-1
- Evacuate the area surrounding the suspicious item(s)
- Provide a description of the location, time, circumstances and details of the suspicious item or person(s)
