SUBJECT: Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall (JBM-HH) Policy Memorandum LG-2, Use of the Appropriated Fund Dining Facility (DFAC)

1. REFERENCES.

- a. AR 30-22, Army Food Program, 24 Jul 12.
- b. DA Pam 30-22, Operating Procedures for the Army Food Program, 6 Feb 07.

2. PURPOSE. To establish policy under which military receiving Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) and civilian personnel who are given approval to dine in Appropriated Fund DFACs, may do so by paying the cashier and reimbursing the Government.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all military personnel and Department of Defense (DoD) civilians using Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall Appropriated Fund DFAC.

4. POLICY. Army Appropriated Fund DFAC are established for the purpose of feeding enlisted Service Members authorized Subsistence-in-Kind (SIK). Service Members not authorized to receive BAS are entitled to subsist without charge and will receive priority at the point of sale. No increase in resources will be made available to subsisting personnel other than SIK. The adequacy of dining facilities' space, equipment, manpower and the potential impact on the quality of assistance to SIK diners; the nature, location, and hours of duty for potential cash customers; and the suitability and availability of non-appropriated fund food service facilities and local civilian feeding establishments have been considered and it has been determined that:

- a. The Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall DFAC does not exceed a 100 percent utilization rate and is hereby designated as a guest and casual dining facility.

- b. Reimbursement is at the DoD Standard Meal Rate.

- c. The Discount Meal Rate will be charged to spouses and other dependents of enlisted personnel in pay grades E-1 through E-4.

5. PROCEDURES. I have determined that it is in the best interest of the Government, due to increased operational efficiency, morale, unit integrity, and good community relations, to authorize the following categories of diners to purchase meals at the DFAC, effective 15 August 2016.

- a. Service Members.

- b. DoD Civilian Personnel on an occasional basis, dine-in only (take-out service prohibited).

(1) Monday – Friday at the JBMHH DFAC: Breakfast: 0630-0830 Lunch: 1130-1300, and Dinner: 1630-1800.

(2) Weekends, Holidays and Training Holidays (unless otherwise posted): Brunch: 0900-1200, Supper: 1600-1730.

c. All other personnel must obtain the Joint Base Commander's written approval to eat in the Appropriated Fund Dining Facility.
