OUR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Army Family Action Plan (AFAP)

AFAP is the Army's grassroots process to identify and elevate the most significant quality of life issues impacting Soldiers (all components), Retirees, Department of Army (DA) Civilians, and Families to senior leaders for action.

Army Family Team Building (AFTB)

AFTB is a series of training modules that cover topics such as basic information about the Army, personal growth skills and leadership skills.

Financial Readiness Program (FRP)

FRP promotes readiness by counseling and educating Soldiers and Families in all areas of consumer and financial topics and ensures that emergency assistance is available when needed. The mission of FRP is to reduce indebtedness, reduce requests for emergency financial assistance, and to prevent financial difficulties before they arise.
